Overview

Gareth Bale is a Welsh footballer who plays as a right wing. He plays for a Premier League club named Tottenham Hotspur on loan from Real Madrid and the national team known as Wales. His time at Tottenham Hotspur he transformed into more of an aggressive player.

Early life

Gareth Bale was born in Cardiff, his parents are Debbie Bale and Frank Bale. He attended Eglwys Newydd Primary and at this school he first came to the attention of Southampton whilst playing a tournament with his first ever club Cardiff Civil Service. Gareth Bale went to Whitchurch High and was good at sports playing football alongside Sam Warburton which is in the future rugby Wales captain.

Football career

When Gareth Bale was 16 years old he became the second youngest player to play for Southampton making his debut with a 2-0 victory after some games he had a reputation of being a free kick specialist. His first full season was described as an incredible first full season as a footballer. In 2007 Gareth Bale signed with Tottenham Hotspur for a 4 year deal for 5 million potentially rising to 10 million based on success. On December 2 2007 Gareth Bale got an injury coming from a tackle. An X-ray scan showed that he got ligament damage to his right ankle.
